If the property is owned by the student or his/her family, it can only be listed through the ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION PROGRAM. The fee for a student listing is \$5. This is a *per listing* fee. The information remains on our database for 30 days beyond the date available and cannot be renewed.

Your information will be made available online and in our office. Once you have made the payment, you will also be able to access your information online and make changes to the information submitted. You can also contact us to make the changes for you. Note: changing the availability date to a later date is not accepted. The student must pay another \$5 fee in this case. Likewise, when the unit is rented, make sure you access your online account and delete the listing, or call the office, so we can delete it. We want to offer our users accurate information and save you unnecessary telephone calls.

If you do not have a place and are looking to share an apartment or house you can list yourself as an available roommate. The roommate available listing is a free service to all the University of Pennsylvania students. You can access the **Roommate Available Registration online** or **request the form from our office**. You can also run a search on our interactive database, check the "shared" options and see if any of the availabilities match your needs and interests.
